Required qualifications

To be eligible for the Post Master Degree in Safety and International regulation of fragrances and cosmetics, applicants must have one of the following postgraduate qualifications:

- Engineering degree from chemical, food, sciences, biological engineering schools
- Master 2-level university diploma, 5 years' higher education studies (life sciences, chemistry)
- Pharmacists, veterinarians, doctors in medicine
- Any other qualification deemed to be of an equivalent level by the selection panel composed of representatives from ESCOM, EBI and ISIPCA
- A 1-year Master's degree or equivalent, with 3 years' meaningful (in-house) professional experience in the sector

You should have a certificate attesting knowledge of the English language. Please note that a B2 level is advisable.

Course fees

- Individual: €10,000, including tax
- Employees: €15,000, including tax
- A student contribution will be also required (for information 90€ in 2018-2019, amount could change for 2019-2020)

Please note: €2,000 must be paid up front to confirm registration once the applicant has been declared admissible.

Applicants on further vocational training courses

The course may be taken through individual training leave (CPF) or the company training scheme, with the support of the relevant joint commission for collective training (OPCA)

Employees and job seekers of French nationality and aged over 26 may submit their application under the further vocational training scheme.

In order to do so, they must return the present registration form, duly completed, which must be accompanied by the following documents: photocopies of qualifications, a CV, a letter of motivation, a letter of company approval for employees or a Pôle Emploi certificate for job seekers.

International applicants

Please note: All documents in a foreign language must be translated into French or at least English by a sworn translator.

International applicants legally residing and working in their respective territories may submit an application.

If you live in a country where the procedure **Etudes en France** is required, you will have to submit an online application on <https://pastel.diplomatie.gouv.fr/etudesenfrance/dyn/public/authentication/login.html?codeLangue=EN> . You can check on this link if your country is concerned. **This procedure is compulsory for your visa application.**

In parallel, this application form, duly completed, and accompanied by the supporting documents, must be returned according to the procedure described below. In addition, these applicants must also provide the following documents:

- a photocopy of the documents certifying the lawful residence and employment status, which must be valid for the entire duration of the course,
- a certificate attesting knowledge of the French language (French Knowledge Test for Preliminary Admission Application (TCF or DELF/DALF = B1))
- For reminder, a certificate attesting knowledge of the English language : a B2 level is advisable

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Submission of applications

- Applications shall be submitted through completion of this form.
- Application forms must be sent via "[we transfer](https://wetransfer.com/)" (<https://wetransfer.com/>) to: mastere-cosmetiques@escom.fr
- The supporting documents listed in the box below **must be included in the electronic application.**
- The qualification required for admission must be obtained in full prior to the course start date; however, please do not wait until the qualification has been received before submitting the form.
- Forms will be selected as soon as full applications have been received. The first interview sessions will begin in June.

Supporting documents which must be enclosed with the files (Electronic version)

The duly completed application form must be submitted to us together with the following supporting documents:

- Recto-verso copy of national ID card or passport
- copy of qualifications obtained
- copy of grade transcripts
- recommendation letter
- CV with photo
- letter of motivation
- evidence of languages levels (English for all candidates, English and French for foreign applicants)
- Payment for the form handling fee: **€200 non-deductible from the registration fees and non-reimbursable**

Admission procedure

Admissibility for the Post Master Degree in Safety and International regulation of fragrances and cosmetics is contingent on the required level of education, the examination of the application form, the results of the interview and the number of posts available.

Candidates are selected by means of a number of steps:

- Examination of the application form upon receipt after payment of the handling fees.
- Invitation to a motivation interview in front of a selection panel composed of leading academics from ESCOM, EBI and ISIPCA.

Please note: interview can be conducted via video conference tools

- Following this interview the members of the selection panel will draw the list of admissible applicants
- Admissible candidates need to confirm their participation to the program by paying € 2000 for registration
